Pet Emergency Kit Checklist

Since our pets completely depend on us for care and safety, we must prepare for them along with our families. Create or update your pet kit today--preparing for your pets makes sense!

Food. At least a three day supply in an airtight, waterproof container.
Water. At least three days of water specifically for your pets.
Medicines and medical records.
Important documentation. Registration information, adoption papers and vaccination documents.
Pet First Aid Kit.
Collar or harness with ID tag, rabies tag and a leash.
A picture of you and your pet together. If you become separated, this will help you document ownership and allow others to assist you.
Toys. Familiar items can help reduce stress for your pet.
Sanitation. Include pet litter box, paper towels, plastic trash bags and household chlorine bleach.
Windbreakers. To keep animals safe from frigid conditions.
Crate. Have a large, sturdy and safe crate or carrier in case you need to evacuate.
